Starting with introductions, networking and an introduction to the importance of impact, followed by a more formal day presenting individual areas of work within the programme, listening to others and identifying areas of cross-programme and cross-sectoral working. Finally, a 'Story telling' training session will enable participants to learn about different narratives and ways of presenting their work. Enabling and encouraging reflection on your individual story and the whole Programme level narrative.
